

- **SueB Urban 5k Route**

- Welcome to the audio description of the 2021 SueB Urban 5k Route. Thanks for supporting the Women's and Children's Alliance!
- Remember, all downtown routes involve traffic and risk; use caution at all intersections and be aware that conditions may change based on construction and other pedestrian activity.

- Begin at the Women's and Children's Alliance building at 720 West Washington. An audio description of the statue in front of the building is available on the event web site.
- Facing the WCA building, proceed Right on W Washington toward 7th Street; Cross 7th Street
- Continue on W Washington toward 6th Street; turn Right on 6th Street and proceed south on 6th
- Cross State Street and continue south to Jefferson
- Cross Jefferson with the traffic signal

- Just after crossing Jefferson there are dog waste bags and a trash can on the right.
- Cecil D Andrus Park is on the right between Jefferson and Bannock
- Continue south on 6th and cross Bannock with the signal
- As you approach Idaho Street, outdoor seating takes up the right side of the sidewalk.

- Cross Idaho Street with the signal and continue south
- Cross Main Street with the signal and continue south
- Cross Grove Street and turn right. The Basque Center is on your left.

- There is a partial fence and row of benches on the sidewalk between the Basque Center and Grove Street, but still enough room for access; stay to the far left of the sidewalk between buildings and the bench seating.
- Be aware of landscaping beds on left between the Basque Center and Basque Museum.
- As you near Bar Gernika, keep left to avoid roped-off seating area.

- As you approach Capitol Boulevard, there is a narrow opening between the Bar Gernika doorway and outdoor seating.
- Note. The Faces of Hope Mural is located across Capitol in the

covered walkway between Capitol and the Boise Grove. An audio description of the mural is available at the event web site.

- Turn left at Capitol Boulevard and proceed south.
- The Mural celebrating Boise's sister city Gernika in the Basque Country is on the Left. An audio description of the Mural is available on the event web site.

- Cross Front Street with the traffic signal
- Trader Joe's is on the left
- Keep to the left side of Capitol Boulevard and continue south

- Cross Broad Street; be aware of cross traffic
- Note. The Faces of Hope office is one block to the left on 6th Street.

- Cross Myrtle Street using the pedestrian signal.
- Cross Fulton (there is no signal, be aware of cross traffic)
- The Idaho Historical Museum, and Idaho Black History Museum are to the Left

- Cross River Street. The Boise Art Museum and Julia Davis Park are on your Left
- Activate pedestrian signal at intersection to cross Capital Boulevard heading west toward Main Library.

- Proceed west for one block; be aware of entry and exit traffic as you approach the Main Library.
- Turn left on 8th Street, keeping the library to your left.

- Continue south on 8th Street for one block
- Be aware of entry and exit traffic at south library parking.
- Arrive at the Wassmuth Center/Anne Frank Memorial
- Enjoy the serenity and meaning of the Wassmuth Center for Human Rights.
- There are waist-high pillars throughout the memorial exhibit, each featuring interpretive audio descriptions. These are activated by four smooth buttons, most with English above and Spanish below.

- To return to the route, backtrack to the intersection of 8th Street and River Street.
- Activate the signal to cross 8th Street and continue west on River Street. Keep to the south side of River Street.

- At the intersection at River and 9th the sidewalk widens to the left, with a curved wall with bench seating.
- At the west end of the wall angle to the left to avoid a utility box.
- The crossing signal button is mounted on a pole about 8 feet to the south of the utility box and in line with the curb cut and cross walk.

- Using the signal, cross 9th Street and continue west on River Street.

- Keeping to the south side of River Street, continue west approximately three blocks. Grass and trees line the left side of the sidewalk.
- There are three unsignaled driveway entries and exits on your left that line up with 10th Street, 11th Street and between Ash Street and the Pioneer Pathway.
- The first driveway is in line with 10th Street and the combined entry and exit is on your left. Curb cuts line up on either side.
- The second driveway is in line with 11th Street and features a one-way exit onto River and a one-way entry from River, separated by a landscaped divider on the left of the path of travel. The curb cuts line up on either side.
- The third driveway is a divided parking entry and exit. The crossing is wider than previous crossings with a wide landscaped divider on the left side of the path of travel The Pioneer Pathway is on the west side of this driveway, just a few feet west of the tactile dome or curb cut.
- Once you reach the Pioneer Pathway, Payette Brewing is to the left, and continuing south on the Pioneer Pathway will connect to the Greenbelt and the Pioneer footbridge.
- (Note. Participants could proceed south on the Pioneer Pathway and cross the Pioneer Footbridge to visit the Sue B Memorial Tree. Once you reach the south end of the footbridge, turn left. The SueB memorial tree will be to the right. An audio description of the tree is available on the event site.
- To return to the route, backtrack north on the Pioneer Footbridge and Pioneer Pathway and continue with the following directions.

- To proceed to downtown Boise from the Pioneer Pathway at River Street, activate the signal beacon to cross River Street heading northeast.

- Continue on the Pioneer Pathway.
- Cross Grand Street (there is no traffic signal) and continue to the intersection of 11th and Myrtle.
- Keep to the left or west side of 11th Street.
- Cross Myrtle Street, being mindful of traffic; there is a signal, but no pedestrian control.
- Cross Front Street with signal; there is no pedestrian control.
- Cross Grove Street with signal; there is no pedestrian control.
- Cross Main Street using pedestrian signal control.
- Cross Idaho Street using pedestrian signal control

- Enjoy a break at Cherie Buckner-Webb Park on the left, just before Bannock. An audio description of the park is available on the event web site.
- Cross Bannock Street using pedestrian signal control

- Turn right on Bannock and proceed east to 8th Street; be aware of cross traffic on 10th and 9th street
- Cross 8th Street, and then turn left to proceed north on 8th.
- Use the signal control to cross Jefferson; the Idaho State Capitol is on your right.
- Cross State Street using the traffic signal. Continue north one block to West Washington Street
- Cross Washington to return to the WCA! Congratulations!
- Remember, an audio description of the Statue in front of the WCA is available at the event web site, narrated by one of the original artists.
